“2+1” Bachelor’s to Master’s Program at the Metropolitan School of Professional Studies (MSPS)

MSPS is excited to announce our new “2+1” programs for undergraduates planning to continue on to one of our master’s degrees – the **HR3 and MSM3 programs**. HR3 or MSM3 students may take up to three (3) graduate, 500-level classes during their senior year. Not only will the classes count toward the 120 credits needed to earn a CUA bachelor’s degree, but they will also give the graduating student a nine-credit head start on a Master of Science in Management (M.S.M.) or a Master of Arts in Human Resource Management (M.A. in HRM). This offering is designed for academically motivated students who want to fast-track meeting their educational goals!

HR3/MSM3 Scholars must commit to full-time undergraduate study, must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better, and must earn a “B” or better in graduate level courses taken at CUA’s MSPS. In turn, Scholars receive a significant tuition discount and special consideration for the M.S.M. or M.A. in HRM program when they apply.

Undergraduate admissions requirements for Scholars include:

- MSPS Application and Application Fee
- Official University and High School/GED Transcripts
- Résumé
- 60+ college credits. Candidates with fewer credits may still be eligible for admission to MSPS and are encouraged to apply. Admission to HR3 or MSM3 programs may be deferred until 60+ credits are earned at CUA
- Statement about intention to continue on to Master’s and relation to educational/career goals
- Letter of recommendation – professional or academic

Once admitted to MSPS, Scholars must meet the following requirements* in order to be eligible to take graduate level courses:

- Complete, with C- or better, the following courses or equivalents:
 - MHUI 51 Rhetoric and Composition & MHUI 52 Composition and Research
 - MIS 105 Microcomputer Applications I
- Complete 90 undergraduate credits
- Possess a 3.0 minimum cumulative GPA
- Complete at least one full term (carrying a minimum of 6 credits) at CUA
